I AM YOU/WE/THEY ARE HE/SHE/IT IS	NOT playING NOT dancING NOT watchING TV

present simple of 'be' + osebek + NOT + verb-ing (zamenjamo vrstni red osebk in glagola ,be')

AM I ARE YOU/WE/THEY IS HE/SHE/IT	playING? dancING? watchING TV?

WHAT AM I WHERE ARE YOU/WE/THEY WHEN IS HE/SHE/IT	playING? dancING? watchING TV?
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- RABA:

- V kontekstu načrtov present continuous uporabljamo za fiksne načrte v prihodnosti (ponavadi z besedo, ki se nanaša na prihodnost – “future time word”). Načrt smo že naredili in smo (bolj ali manj) prepričani, da se bo uresničil.

I'm meeting my father tomorrow.

We're going to the beach at the weekend.

I'm leaving at three.

They're coming to the party at the weekend.

- Stvari, ki se dogajajo v tem trenutku (ko govorimo)

I'm working at the moment.
Please call back as– we are eating dinner now.
Julie is sleeping.
You are studying the present continuous.

- Začasne situacije, stanja, za katera domnevamo, da ne bodo trajala dolgo

She's staying with her friend for a week.
I'm living in London for a few months.
John's working in a bar until he finds a job in his field.
I'm reading a really great book.

- Začasne navade ali nove navade (za 'normalne' navade, ki trajajo dalj časa, uporabljamo present simple)

He's eating a lot these days.
She's swimming every morning (she didn't use to do this).
You're smoking too much.
They're working late every night.

- Navade, ki nam gredo na živce, ko želimo izraziti, da se nekaj dogaja prepogosto in nas moti – v tem primeru ponavadi uporabimo prislove kot 'always', 'constantly', 'forever'

You're always losing your keys!
She's constantly missing the train.
He's always sleeping in.
They're forever being late.

- Situacije, ki se počasi spreminjajo.

I'm getting better at playing the piano.
The weather is improving.
The days are getting longer.

SPREMEMBE PRI ČRKOVANJU

- 'silent e': 'e', ki je v glagolu tih, izgine (oz. če se beseda konča na soglasnik + e, e odpade)

dance → dancING
make → making

- Podvajanje zadnjega soglasnika: pri enozložnih glagolih in dvozložnih glagolih z naglasom na drugem zlogu in zaporedjem soglasnik/samoglasnik/soglasnik na koncu besede, se zadnji soglasnik podvoji (CVC)

swim → swiMMing
run → ruNNing
get → geTTing

commit → commiTTing

AMPAK!

open → opening

whisper → whispering

- W, Y, Z: besede, ki se končajo na w, y, z, se ne podvajajo

box → boxing

enjoy → enjoying

- le → y: končnica –ie postane –y

die → dying
